Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after Closing

SMKC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing on Sept. 10. 2024. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date. Any entries withdrawn that are received by Sun., Sept. 22, 2024 @ 6pm, will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Sun., Sept. 22, 2024 @ 6pm will receive a full refund.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size. Limit 10 entries per envelope.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, back of entry form with agreement, or fees, nor will telephone or FAX entries be accepted.

- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$25 service fee will be added for all returned checks.

INVALID ENTRIES

Invalid entries will be returned to the address on the entry form. The following constitute an invalid entry:

- An entry which is missing any AKC required information
- Entries not on Official AKC forms or on a photocopy of an AKC form without the current AKC agreement on the reverse side or attached to the entry form
- Entries which are illegible or incomplete, or entries received with insufficient fees
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, e-mail, telephone, FAX, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry
- A maximum of ten entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than the ten dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

- Confirmations will be sent via US mail ONLY if an exhibitor does not have an active email address or upon specific request.
- A Preliminary Confirmation will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC entry form after your entry has been processed. Please review the information in the confirmation for input errors and notify the Trial Secretary of any corrections.

Final confirmations of entry and judging schedule will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC form after the closing date.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. SMKC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. SMKC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the SMKC or any official thereof. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season and Dogs under 4 months of age will not be admitted to the trial.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. Qualifying flat ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. MACH/PACH Rosettes and a decorated MACH/PACH bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH/PACH title at this trial. If a PAX is earned at the same time, the exhibitor may choose between either the PACH or PAX ribbon. New title ribbons will be given to dogs earning a new title. AGCH Bar is available.

All ribbons and prizes must be claimed the day of the Trial; none will be mailed.

MOVE UPS

Move ups must be sent in writing with the information below (E-mail is acceptable and preferred) to the Trial Secretary for the September 27th trial no later than Monday, September 23rd at 6pm.

Day to Day move ups (FRI to SAT and SAT to SUN) must be submitted in person to the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last run is judged for each class (STD, JWW & FAST).

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

If your dog needs to be measured, check the box at the top of the entry form so that your dog is placed on the Measuring List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A <u>separate entry form</u> must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for AKC agility trials.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at http://www.akc.org/rules/.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO) SMKC is offering classes FEO in all classes

- FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is now offered in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es)
 prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must
 record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO
 does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day
 of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an
 ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must
 declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not
 allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the class level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

REFUNDS

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on the date of the trial.

Injury//Illness – Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be given a partial refund minus **\$10 per run**.

A written vet letter (on office letterhead) must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on Friday, September 27, 2024.

Documentation of the injury/illness must be made in a writing signed and dated by a licensed veterinarian stating that the dog cannot compete at this specific set of trials and/or providing a time period from the date on the written note from the veterinarian during which the dog cannot compete. Requests from chiropractors, massage/physical therapists, etc will not be accepted. All injury partial refunds subject to verification. Handler illness/injury is excluded from this policy.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running, If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
